FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS? WHY ALUC FOR EACH GAME AND TURNING IT IN?

The AYSO line up card (ALUC) is very important for AYSO. It is the legal document which is first referred when questions come up about the game. Both Referees and Coaches are responsible for proper completing ALUC in a manner as is described. The examples are on our regional website in various menu items like: COACH/REFEFEE/MANAGER (stock card print), FORMS/SPONSORS > AYSO Line Up Card >

The most import thing is to make sure that the line up card is properly filled in. An improperly filled in ALUC must be re-done. See https://dt5602vnjxv0c.cloudfront.net/portals/14613/docs/ayso line up card.pdf

Referees and coaches should make sure that the card looks neat and has all the current information on it. ALL players in your team must be listed on the ALUC. When not present for the day write A B S E N T in the last 6 columns. DO NOT line out. If you are not sure then put a "X" If player is late put "L" if the player is in the goal put "GK" or "G"

Referees complete the card on the back side and coaches sign the card as accurately reflecting the substitutions and the score. The coach is responsible that all players have the chance to play on the pitch during the game as per "Every One Plays" and "Player Development" The referee is responsible to deliver both ALUC to the ref table.

IF there is no referee on the game then the coach must complete the ALUC and sign it and include any comments he/she may have. The coach of the team which kicked off on first half brings BOTH ALUC to the Ref Table.
